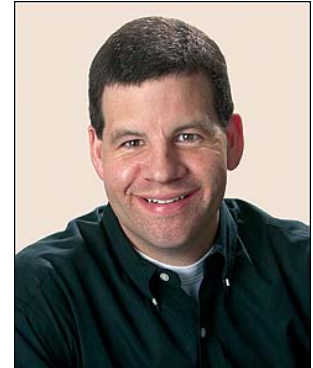

Important Conference Notes:

We are really excited!! This is the year when we are finally going to capture the full essence of what SADD is all about – ***the mystery of SADD*** – and you are going to help us figure it out! The question is.... *Why didn't we think of this earlier??*

Each chapter is asked to bring a table sign (no larger than 12"x18") with your school or chapter name on it. (Don't forget to bring a large banner to hang, too!) **Also, and this is vitally important** – we need each chapter to bring a small sheet of paper on which is written one or two lines stating what **YOUR** chapter thinks is the most important ingredient of SADD. Is it "knowledge?" Is it "courage?" Is it "individuality?" We don't know. That's why we need your help. Discuss the factors among your chapter members, settle on a key component, and write it down to share with us. Be sure to bring this with you!

Monday evening: In addition to our traditional free time followed by the dance, this year we have an opportunity to do something really special. We have been granted a stipend to conduct what has got to be the **biggest** and **most unique** Town Hall meeting on underage drinking and alcohol abuse the upper Midwest has ever seen. These Town Hall meetings will be taking place the week of March 22 all across the nation, but **nowhere** is there going to be a meeting benefiting from the attendance of youth leaders from 50 or more SADD chapters from across the region. This is a very recent development and as of the time I am writing this, details are still being worked out. Naturally, everyone can't attend an event like this, but we will be asking each advisor to nominate a small number of students to represent your chapter. They will be taken care of and fed prior to the meeting, so this won't interfere with your other free-time plans. Be looking for more details on this.

SADD Store: As usual, we will have a SADD store open during free times throughout the conference. At the store you will be able to buy tee shirts, other SADD items and chapter supplies.

Attire: Dress throughout the conference is casual, **EXCEPT for the awards luncheon on Tuesday**. Guys should wear a shirt & tie or polo shirt. No blue jeans.
