Article I. Entitlements:

Deserving of individuality, equality, respect, a positive self-image, confidence and not subject to prejudgment.

Worthy of being free from physical, emotional, mental, verbal, and substance abuse.

Capable of resiliency to overcome adversity and positively influence others.

Article II, Actions

Therefore we will:

Be inclusive and supporting of all youth regardless of prior circumstance.

Provide a peer network to educate, motivate, and advocate on behalf of our collective well-being.

Promote health and safety by collaborating with teens, caring adults, and community assets.

Create a substance-free, safe haven where young people can be themselves and accepted for who they are.

Prioritize behavioral health, realizing that mental health issues are just as serious as physical illnesses, and providing resources and acceptance to those who need it.

Listen to our peers to inspire creativity, a culture of innovation, new ideas, and positive change.

Through all our efforts, we, as youth, will facilitate strong leadership development in order to find solutions to the problems of today and tomorrow.
